The answer to this question changes daily. We all receive increased revelation and insight into our Father's thinking every time we sit in His presence. But for the sake of this writing there are three truths from the Word of God that I'm compelled to mention because the application of them will consistently save you from wrong thinking related to fear. They will also prevent me from ever repeating a conversation I had with the Lord Jesus in 1993. I'll share that conversation a little later, but suffice it to say thank goodness that was then and this is now. You'll see that what you know about spiritual things will not affect God's acceptance of you however, it will affect how consistently you receive from Him.

Thanks be to God for His goodness and His grace forever!

# 1

## RECOGNIZE AND RESIST THE ENEMY

The number one way Satan, the enemy, defeats Christians today is to get them to question the love the Father has for them. If he can get you to question God's unfailing love for you, in your current situation, then the enemy creates a crack in your Blessing wall of thinking. He will flood your mind with further thoughts of how your situation is unique and how God won't be able to help you this time. If you continue to think about these things, you will begin to say them.<sup>1</sup> This is exactly what the enemy needs, us to yield the POWER of our words to him. He has no power; he needs our words to successfully steal, kill, or destroy in our lives.<sup>2</sup>

**Why does the enemy try to get you to question Love?** Whether it's the Father's love for you, your love for others, or others' love for you, he provokes you to question the principle of love because God is Love and *love is what connects everything in the spirit realm*. Loved people love people. Knowing, believing, and receiving the unconditional Love the Father has for you is what brings you to a "never fail" position. The enemy has to attack your understanding of the love of God to defeat you.<sup>3</sup>



When thoughts of worry, anxiety, concern — all based in fear — cross your mind, you must choose to cast them down immediately and bring your thinking into focus on the truth of the Word of God. For God has not given you the spirit of fear but of power and of love and of a sound mind. Say out loud, “Satan you are a liar! I rebuke you! Jesus loves me so much He gave His life that I would be saved and delivered out of every trouble, and every trouble includes this situation!”<sup>4</sup> At the first thought of you not being loved and provided for by God Almighty Himself, stop. Submit to God. Resist the devil, and he must flee.<sup>5</sup>

## 2

### USE YOUR SECRET WEAPON — SSS

There is one sure way to quickly recover from the temptation of fearful thinking and move forward in victory. I call it triple S.

SSS means **SEE** it from the **SPIRIT SIDE**. To submit to God and resist the devil is to see your situation from the position your Father created for your life. When you agree with what He sees, by saying what He says, a supernatural process happens.

1. **Seeing your situation from the Spirit side exchanges fear for faith.** The minute you choose to focus on the love God has for you, you see His Son on the cross and that every need in your life was addressed then, once and for all. Fear-full thoughts transition to thank-full thoughts.<sup>6</sup>
2. **SSS — Now you begin to thank God for His love.** In everything give thanks, for this is the will of God for you, do not quench the Spirit. You're not thankful for the situation but in the situation. Rather than quench the Spirit with fear your faith action of thanksgiving yields your power-filled words to the Holy Spirit.<sup>7</sup>
3. **You have created a faith environment.** The Spirit takes the words of thanksgiving and begins to create the things you are thanking Him for. **He may now craft a divine act into your situation, for He watches over His Word to perform it.**<sup>8</sup>

Seeing your situation from the Spirit Side is a glorious way to live! The more I practice SSS the more my Father is permitted to hear words of thanksgiving and agreement come out of my mouth. The faithful Father watches over His Words to perform them.<sup>9</sup>

SEE it from the **SPIRIT SIDE** — SSS is your secret weapon! It's so powerful that I'm going to repeat the process of application.

1. **Submit to God and resist the devil**—See your Fathers' act of love through the price paid at the cross. Jesus' blood was enough to cover all of your life situations, once and for all.
2. **By faith, start to thank God** that His proven love for you is more than enough. Believe in your heart and say with your mouth, "I receive Your abundant provision today."<sup>10</sup>
3. **Yield your words of faith to the Holy Spirit.** This permits Him to create the solution for your personal situation. Say, *"Holy Spirit, you know all things about all things. Please take this situation and make all grace abound toward me that I always have all sufficiency in all things and the ability to give unto others as well. Thank you for your love. I receive it by faith and by grace. Amen."*<sup>11</sup>

# 3

## CONSISTENCY = POWER

Know this, according to His Promise: The Father doesn't come through for you sometimes, or most of the time, but every time! Reflect back and see how His love has delivered you out of trouble, lack, sickness, sadness, you name it, not just one time but every time. If you haven't seen the complete manifestation of God's work in a certain situation yet, don't you dare stop believing! He will not forsake you nor loose His hold on your situation, nor let you down, He will not. Continue to believe His love and you will not fail to receive.<sup>12</sup>

When the enemy brings the next lie to you about how this need won't be met, there must come a time in your life when you trust God and do not permit lies to affect you with anxiety or doubt. **How?** By remembering the hundreds of times the Father delivered you and set you on high and by **knowing and believing the Love the Father has for you**. You will be led by the Spirit and choose to say what the Father says in the face of the liar. *"Now thanks be to God who ALWAYS leads me in triumph in Christ!"*<sup>13</sup> Not sometimes, not because I'm perfect, but because He is perfect and His love toward me is perfect. **What does always mean?** It means always!

Say out loud, *“Father, I agree with Your Holy Word. Thanks be to God who ALWAYS leads me in triumph in Christ! I believe I receive your leading by faith. Go ahead and craft a divine act into my life according to the power of the Holy Spirit within me. To You be all the glory!”*

For you to be consistent in believing the love God has for you is to be a mature son of God. In consistency lies the power. By this I mean yielding consistently to the Holy Spirit, saying what He says over your life, permitting Him to craft divine acts for you from the words of faith spoken from your lips.

## **EASY AND LIGHT**

You must not let the enemy tell you this is hard; remember he is the father of lies. The truth is that your Father, through Jesus said, *“My yoke is easy and My burden is light.”*<sup>14</sup> Your fellowship time with the Lord will wash out all fear and leave you in perfect peace, transforming your thinking to agree with His.

It's during your reading, studying, and fellowship time that the Holy Spirit truly becomes your Comforter, Counselor, Helper, Intercessor, Advocate, Strengtheners, and Standby, which will remain with you forever.<sup>15</sup> He teaches us to consistently See from the Spirit Side. The loving Holy Spirit is the one who created all things and He is the one who will craft a divine act into your life.

He will teach you all things. And He will cause you to recall (will remind you of, bring to your remembrance) everything the Father reveals to you.<sup>16</sup>

## **WHAT DID I DO THEN THAT I WON'T DO NOW?**

The winter of 1993 was a record year for snow drifts in Fort Klamath, Oregon. The deep drifts made it hard for my husband, Lawrence, to continue his logging business, and then the job came to an end. The equipment payments were due soon and were thousands of dollars each month. My salary couldn't come close to covering them.

To add to our financial situation we had a house for sale that needed to sell quickly in order for us to begin making payments on the new home we had just purchased and moved into. We had shoveled the deep snow from the roof of the house that was for sale, but it snowed regularly and now the snow on the ground was so high that it touched the eaves of the roof. We could no longer see the house from the nearby road. It looked like a large lump of snow sitting in the middle of a clearing. How could we sell it?

We had been Word of Faith Christians for nearly 10 years now and we knew what to do. This time we would look to Jesus, our Provider, with a greater need than we had ever experienced before. In the natural there was no way that we could meet our obligations. We needed supernatural help.

When I wasn't at work and Lawrence wasn't shoveling or plowing snow, we were in our living room reading the Word of God, underlining the scriptures of promise that spoke to our situation of need. Our covenant with God told us that our needs would be met according to His riches and that as we called upon Him in trouble He would deliver us with honor.<sup>17</sup> We would pray in the Spirit, and then read our Bible again to remind ourselves of *our* covenant. We believed that God could not lie and that He was able to turn this situation around for us. He had never let us down since we had come to know Him.

Soon a month slipped by and things looked worse rather than better, but we continued to seek the Lord. Our prayer and reading time became our time of peace. Other times Satan would bring condemning thoughts to bombard our minds — everyone knows you are about to fail — your situation is different this time and God won't be able to help you — why did you choose this line of work — why did you buy that house

now —you brought this on yourselves — do you pray enough, tithe and give enough — something is not working and you need to figure it out — when you fail it will be a mockery to God. Of course the enemy was doing his best to steal the Word of God's Promise out of our hearts. If he could steal the Word of God and get us to speak unbelief, then he could steal our victory using our own words, the very words that our Father had intended for us to use to bring life and life abundantly into our situation. The pressure was awful!<sup>18</sup>

One day, as I sat there on the couch with my Bible on my lap, I thought to myself, I have prayed, spoken the scripture promises, cast down, bound, loosed, and everything else I know to do. Why is my stomach still in these knots of torment? I know that I need to believe God and that He will deliver us out of this situation with honor. But the devil fights you right down to the last ¼ of an inch; it's his way. The next thought that came was, *"What difference does it make if God does deliver you out of this trouble? There will be more. What about next year, what about five years from now, what about when the kids need to go to college, and what about your retirement?"*

I know how ridiculous this sounds now, but when you are under the pressure of how to come out of trouble the devil will pile on whatever images he thinks you will



accept in hopes that you will yield your words to the pressure and say something in fear. A fear environment is his only hope of power. The enemy needs us to receive the weight and responsibility of how we will fix the situation. Well, glory to God that situation did get fixed! Please listen carefully as this same solution will fix your impossible situations.

My surroundings that day were a nice warm home with a loving husband and two beautiful children... but I felt alone, defeated, and that I was a failure and mockery for God. It seemed that the more I cast down imaginations that exalted themselves against the Promise of God that equal amounts of negative thoughts would bring pictures of failure.

I closed my eyes and within me said, "Lord, I'm asking you to help me see things right. This pressure, fear, worry, are not from you. I'm not created to bear it. In fact your Holy Word tells me that you bore fear and torment for me, through Jesus at the cross. Help me see this from your side, the Spirit side."<sup>19</sup>

Within seconds I saw a huge group of people, walking in a long, flowing line. The line was perhaps twenty people wide and nearly a mile long and I was in the flow with them. We were walking at a good pace along a wide path through a grassy meadow that wound

upward to the top of a hill. At the top of the hill I could see tall, majestic doors open wide and people pouring in.

All the people in this line were joyful and excited, smiling and looking straight ahead. They were not talking to one another but saying things like “*Glory, praise His Name. It’s our time to be with the Lamb of God.*” I realized the heaviness that had been on me was gone; the torment inside of me had been replaced with peace, expectancy, and joy. I understood that we were headed to see Jesus Himself. He was standing at the doors personally greeting each of the people who were entering.

We seemed to be close quickly. I could see Jesus as He spoke with those ahead of me. He took a few seconds with each one to welcome them to the feast He had prepared in their honor. As I came closer I could sense the love, compassion, mercy, grace, appreciation, and acceptance in His very presence.

Then I was there. As with the others, He extended his hands and took both of mine into His. There was such love in His presence. He said, “*Welcome, Ann.*” He knew our names. His presence permeated grace and beloved acceptance. I was speechless. I glanced past Him and saw the huge banquet room where supper

had been prepared and thousands of people were taking their seats. I didn't look directly into His face but I felt Him looking lovingly at me. In a few seconds my greeting would be over. He leaned closer to me and said, *"I have one question for you."* I couldn't speak. Then He said, *"You are home early...what was it that you thought I couldn't take care of for you?"*

At first I let the question sink in. I had no answer. Then many thoughts flashed across my mind, the finances, the house, the economy, jobs, bad reports, college, and all of the things that had seemed too hard for me now and in my future. Each thing that seemed so big before suddenly seemed insignificant in His presence, not even worthy of mention. He knew my answer yet He waited. Finally, I knew what my answer was. I said, *"Jesus... You are right. I'm here much too early. I'll be back."* Instead of going into the supper room with the others I stepped to the side, when I looked up I found myself on my couch at home.

I took a deep breath. One thing had drastically changed. The home, the snow, the financial challenges that I couldn't fix were all the same. The thing that had changed was MY PERCEPTION OF JESUS. Jesus was now in the right place in my believing and thinking — exalted above all else — and because of this the torment was gone. I made a permanent choice that day to

believe the love that my Lord Jesus had for me and to know that I was not alone, not then, not ever. I made a decision that moment and it was this: *“Knowing what I know now, I will never do that again!”* My perception of reality had changed.

I refuse to ever go before Jesus again in unbelief, as though His sacrifice at the cross had never existed and as if He had not provided everything I will ever need or desire to be victorious in this life. I refuse to think for one minute, *“Master, carest thou not?”*

## THERE IS NOTHING IS TOO HARD FOR GOD ~ **Genesis 18:14**

Satan didn't stop lying and the impossible circumstances didn't change that day. What changed was that I determined to be a more mature child of God and see things from a different point of view, the Spirit side. I submitted to God by casting down Satan's lies and speaking boldly my thankfulness to Jesus for what He had provided when He went to the cross! I determined that God meant what He said when He declared, *“Now thanks be to God who ALWAYS leads us in triumph in Christ.”* It became real to me that greater is He that is in me than he that is in the world. <sup>20</sup> I asked the Holy Spirit within me to lead me to choose His Words and to craft a creative miracle in our lives.

In the winter of 1993 Lawrence was back to work with his logging business within the next 30 days. Within 90 days all bills were paid with an additional \$40,000 in the business checking. Within four months the snow-covered house sold for a Blessed price. We were pardoned from making any payments on the new house until the other sale was completed. There was no interest charged. A few years later we sent both of our children to college where they both received a Bachelors and one of them a master's degree, debt free. All of these things were supernatural and we give all of the Glory to God! There have been too many supernatural manifestations of God's grace in our lives to list them in this small book, for He is altogether lovely. After all, we serve a supernatural God of love.

## **BELIEVING GOD'S LOVE THROUGH JESUS WILL ALWAYS EQUAL OUR VICTORY**

The greater our revelation of Jesus our Lord, the easier we receive all that we need from Him. We still renew our minds daily, transforming our thinking to stay in agreement with the grace of God and what Jesus fully provided for us. We thankfully remember His death until He comes. Like Abraham, we have learned to consider God to be reliable and trustworthy and true to His Word. We are thankful to be led from within by

an unction from the precious Holy Spirit. He knows all things about all things and will only say what the Father says. We aspire to yield to Him each day and only say what He says.

It has been 20 years since the day of that vision with Jesus, who is complete grace, to those who receive Him. I have only shared it a few times. But now, the Lord impressed me to write this experience down that it may shine light on His love for those who will read this book. He wants you to live a fear-free life, for He has not given us a spirit of fear but a Spirit of power and of love and of a sound mind.<sup>21</sup>

If you are tempted to be in fear and worry, ask yourself this important question: *“What is it that I don’t think Jesus took care of at the cross?”* The correct answer is: **“Absolutely nothing.”**

## LEARN GRACE

It’s vitally important that you know that it’s the goodness of God that leads you to repentance or to change your way of thinking.<sup>22</sup> His way of thinking, His way of Seeing from the Spirit Side is that He sees you completely covered in every situation of your life... covered by His Son’s blood.

## STANDING IN UNBELIEF — IN THE PRESENCE OF JESUS

I was in fear and worry, guilty of wrong thinking in the very presence of Jesus. How did I feel when Jesus asked me, “*What was it that you thought I couldn’t take care of for you?*” Did I feel shame, embarrassment, guilt? I couldn’t — those emotions are not in His presence. Not in Heaven and not on earth, Glory to God! I felt complete love, acceptance, encouragement, enlightenment, and extreme determination not to accept defeat for one more minute. I did not feel one ounce of guilt or shame. To wonder if I had given enough self-effort was absurd, He had given all of the self-effort on the cross. My responsibility, then and now, is to believe on Him and receive my gift of right standing and grace by saying what He says about me. I’m redeemed. Never forget that there is no condemnation, not one tiny bit, for those who are in Christ Jesus.<sup>23</sup>

### ANOTHER WORD FOR FEAR = PRIDE

Not until I sat down to write this book did the Holy Spirit reveal to me that to react to, or give place to, worry, fear, or pressures of this world is a form of pride. It means that I think something trying to harm me is greater than God. To believe fear over believing His love

for me is a form of pride and idolatry. Strong words. To yield to fear means that I respect what a storm **can** do more than I respect what the Love of God, through Jesus at the cross, **has done** for me.<sup>24</sup> Pause and think about that.

To put fear first is to say God's love for me, through Jesus' finished work, is not enough. To know and believe the love He has for me will shed light on the truth and drive out all fear. It has to. There is no fear in love.

1 John 4:18 — There is no fear in love; but perfect love casts out fear: because fear has torment. He that fears is not made perfect in love.



## PEACE... FOR THE LONG TERM

Today Jesus wants you to know that no matter what pressure your circumstances may be presenting — financial, physical, relationships, work, your business — He has made the way for you to be delivered with honor and to prosper at what you put your hand to. He will keep you in perfect peace, *Whose mind is stayed on Him.*<sup>25</sup>

Peace I leave with you; My [own] peace I now give *and* bequeath to you. Not as the world gives do I give to you. Do not let your hearts be troubled, neither let them be afraid. [Stop allowing yourselves to be agitated and disturbed; and do not permit yourselves to be fearful and intimidated and cowardly and unsettled.]<sup>26</sup>

If you know Jesus as your Lord, then the same Spirit that raised Christ from the dead and created the entire universe dwells in you. Everything you will ever need in your life is within you waiting to come out in the form of faith filled words. The Holy Spirit knows all things about all things and He desires to teach you and lead you to triumph.

The way you see Jesus, the understanding that you have of His unconditional, unearned, undeserved love for you, will not affect God's acceptance of you. You are His beloved, period. It will affect how you receive from Him. When you truly believe that someone loves you this deeply you will begin to respond by accepting His love as genuine and begin receiving it by remembering His goodness toward you throughout your day. This knowledge is what will bring you joy unspeakable. There is nothing like being loved, accepted, and encouraged all day... every day. This love is available to all that will receive it.

Today I am the happiest I have ever been in my life, I choose to be happy every day! It's true. It's a blessed way to live for sure. How can I say this? Not because circumstances look perfect every day, but because God is with me and I am fully persuaded that nothing is too hard or wonderful for Him to lead me through or overcome. The joy of the Lord is my strength. It's not easy to explain what "happy" every day looks like, but this might help.

Would it be easier for you to be joyful every day if these emotions weren't in the front of your thinking? Fear about what people may do, worry that there won't be enough, anxiety, stress, shame, guilt?

If you were to look up the word *salvation* in the Greek language, related to what Jesus provided through the finished work of the cross, the definition is below. I would use these same words to describe the peace Jesus brings when you put your eyes on Him:

Salvation: Made alive, rescued, preserved, delivered out of trouble, aided, prosperity, health, helped, do well, be free, be safe, defended from the enemy, get victory. Opening of a dungeon/prison, delivered, ease, soundness, forgiveness of sins, answers to prayer, joy, peace.

His grace is amazing and it's here for us to receive every day.

My desire is for you to have an accurate understanding of who Jesus is, because when your revelation of Jesus is big you will know what has been freely given to you. And when you know what is yours in Christ Jesus, you will be rich in all things.

Knowing what you know about the Love the Father has for you, I pray that you will always remember there is **nothing too hard or too wonderful for God to accomplish in your life!**<sup>27</sup>

Give God the Glory for He is with you.

27. Genesis 18:14 AMP Is anything too hard or too wonderful for the Lord? At the appointed time, when the season [for her delivery] comes around, I will return to you and Sarah shall have borne a son.

Jeremiah 32:17 AMP Alas, Lord God! Behold, You have made the heavens and the earth by Your great power and by Your outstretched arm! There is nothing too hard or too wonderful for You.



## PRAYER OF SALVATION AND BAPTISM IN THE HOLY SPIRIT

If you do not know Jesus as your Lord and Savior, simply pray the following prayer in faith, and Jesus will be your Lord!

*'Heavenly Father, I come to You in the Name of Jesus. Your Word says, "Whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved" (Acts 2:21). I am calling on You. I pray and ask Jesus to come into my heart and be Lord over my life according to Romans 10:9-10: "If thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God has raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation." I do that now. I confess that Jesus is Lord, and I believe in my heart that God raised Him from the dead.*

*"I am now reborn! I am a Christian—a child of Almighty God! I am saved! You also said in Your Word, 'If ye then being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children: HOW MUCH MORE shall your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to them that ask him?'" (Luke 11:13). I'm also asking You to fill me with the Holy Spirit. Holy Spirit, rise up within me as I praise God. I fully expect to speak with other tongues as You give me the utterance (Acts 2:4). In Jesus' Name. Amen!"*

Begin to praise God for filling you with the Holy Spirit. Speak those words and syllables you receive—not in your own language, but the language given to you by the Holy Spirit. You have to use your own voice. God will not force you to speak. Don't be concerned with how it sounds. It is a heavenly language!

Continue with the blessing God has given you and pray in tongues each day. You are a born-again, Spirit-filled believer. You'll never be the same!

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
