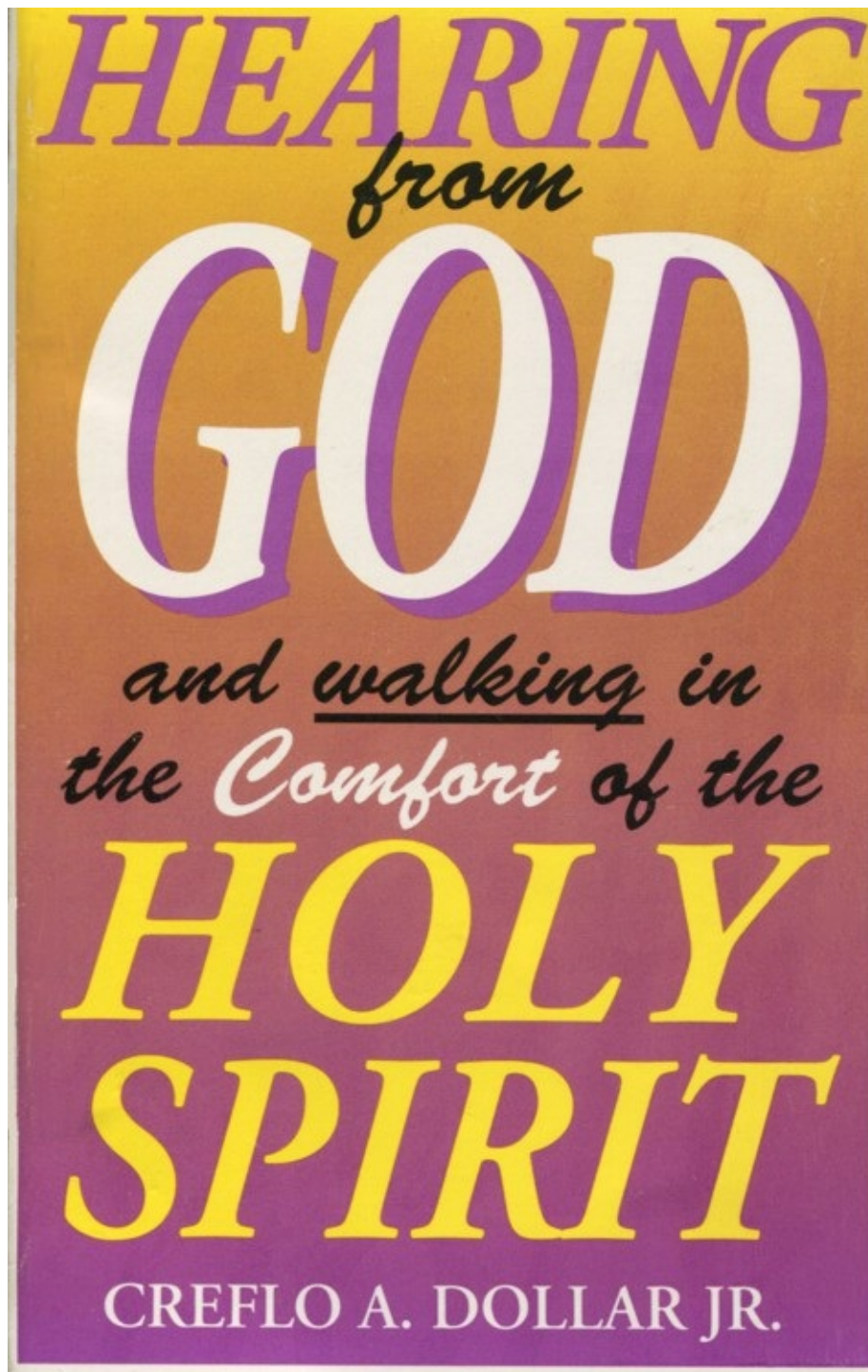

Part 1

Hearing from God

1

Trouble. Hard, unforgiving, strength-testing trouble. Like it or not, it's an inevitable part of every life—including yours. Rich, poor, black, white... we all experience trouble at various times. In fact, Jesus himself guaranteed it! "*In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world.*" (John 16:33)

Yes, all Christians experience trouble, but have you ever noticed that some people seem to always come through it smelling like a rose? Have you ever wondered how some

believers can walk through tough times with calm assurance and smiles on their faces? Or why some always seem to experience miraculous deliverance while the rest take it on the chin?

I have news for you. These people aren't

specially favored by God. They don't enjoy any special privileges. They have the same Word to which you have access. They have the same Holy Spirit that dwells within you. The difference is—they've discovered the secret of hearing from God and walking in the comfort of the Holy Spirit.

These believers have the key to coming through trouble in peace, power and praise. And you can have it too. That's what this little book is all about.

Hearing from Heaven

Even though we live in a world full of turmoil and tribulation, God has made it possible for you to hear his voice of direction. And being able to hear from heaven is absolutely critical if you are going to know how to respond to trouble.

Why is hearing God's voice so important?

Because it allows you to get God's perspective of your situation. In a time of crisis, there is simply no way you are going to

know what to do if all you have is your own outlook on the situation.

A good illustration is a traffic jam in a large city. From street level it is impossible to know what the traffic flow is like around the next corner, not to mention ten miles up the road. That's why many radio stations provide airborne traffic reports from helicopters.

From his vantage point high above the city, a traffic reporter can warn you of accidents and tie-ups long before you ever get there. Even better, he can recommend an alternative route that will guide you around the really bad spots.

The same is true where God and you are concerned. When you are in the middle of a trying situation, there is no way you are going to have all the facts you need to make good decisions. God, on the other hand, sees the whole picture from beginning to end. Best of all, He wants to give you the wisdom and insight you need to get out of the circumstance and come out a winner.

But just as it is impossible to obtain a traffic report unless you have your radio tuned to the right station, so it is impossible to get God's perspective unless you know how to

hear from heaven!

Child of God, tuning into heaven is the answer to whatever trouble you are facing today. Time and time again, scripture links together the concepts of deliverance from trouble and hearing God's instructions.

Thou art my hiding place; thou shalt preserve me from trouble;... I will instruct thee and teach thee in the way which thou shalt go: I will guide thee with mine eye.

(Psalm 32:7, 8)

Seeing your problems from God's vantage point puts them in their proper perspective.

Many Christians have the dangerous tendency to magnify their problems. If you're filled with worry and anxiety, it's because you have big problems and a small God.

It's very easy to magnify your problems

when all you've got is your own perspective.

But when you get God's viewpoint on your situation, suddenly your problems seem very small. Suddenly you have a very big God and some tiny, insignificant problems!

"But, Pastor Dollar! I don't know **how** to hear the voice of God!"

Don't despair. In the next few pages we'll look at two surefire methods for hearing from heaven. But, first you must know about the

one thing that will stop you from hearing
God's voice every time.

Get the Sin Out

Nothing will close your ears to the voice
of God's Spirit faster and more completely
than the presence of sin in your life. That may
be the last thing you want to hear right now,
but it's the truth just the same.

Why does sin destroy your ability to hear
from heaven? Because it destroys your
confidence toward God.

*Beloved, if our heart condemn us not,
then have we confidence toward God. (1
John 3:21)*

When you have unconfessed sin in your
life, your heart condemns you. Take note—
it's not God that condemns you. *"There is
therefore now no condemnation to them which
are in Christ Jesus."* (Romans 8:1) Rather,
your heart, the inner soulish part of you,
shrinks back from approaching God.

When your heart condemns you because
of the presence of sin in your life, you end up
depending on someone else to do your praying
for you. You'll look for "welfare solutions" to
your trouble—the kind that don't require you
to make any effort of your own.

Christians in this condition will sit

through dozens of counseling sessions.

They'll call friends at all hours of the day and night asking for prayer. They'll do everything except the one thing that will restore them to fellowship with their Heavenly Father. That is, calling the sin "sin," confessing it and

getting it out of their lives.

You can't walk around with your heart condemning you and expect to have any sensitivity to the voice of God. It simply won't work that way. You must judge yourself because no one else can do it for you.

Ask the Holy Spirit to examine your heart with the searchlight of God's Word. Then be ready and determined to get rid of any uncleanness that is exposed.

God wants us to live holy lives. Why? Is it because He wants to throw His weight around and take away all your fun? No! It's because he wants to bless you exceeding abundantly beyond all you could ask or think! (Ephesians 3:20)

Sin will destroy you but God wants to bless you. However, God can't bless a dirty vessel. Getting the sin out is the first step toward enjoying the blessing of hearing from God. And, oh, is it a blessing!

Just one word from God can save your

life. Just one word from God can make you rich. Just one word can make all the difference in the world for you. His words bring salvation. His words bring protection. They bring deliverance, safety, soundness and healing.

Don't you realize that everything God has ever done, He has done through His Word? That is why He wants you to be able to hear from Him. He speaks in order to tell you exactly how to experience the abundant life.

Two Channels of Communication

"Alright, Pastor Dollar, you've convinced me. I've dealt with the unconfessed sin in my life, but I still don't know how to hear God."

There are basically two ways in which God speaks to His children. The first and most common way is through His written Word.

All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in

righteousness: (II Timothy 3:16)

God's Word is always profitable to you. It contains His will and His ways. It is far more than just words on paper. It is a manifestation of the very life and power of God himself. According to Hebrews 4:12 it is actually a

living force!

For the word of God is living and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart.

(NIV)

Do you need to know the will of God concerning a certain matter? Go to His Word. God's Word is His will. His will is His Word.

Do you need the wisdom of Heaven when faced with a big decision? Get your Bible.

You'll have the very wisdom on Almighty God at your fingertips.

God's Word will always produce. It never fails.

So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it. (Isaiah 55:11)

The effectiveness of God's Word is not the problem. Our tendency to turn to our emotions in a time of trouble rather than turning to the Word, is the problem. Still, God has yet another way in which to communicate with us.

The Inner Voice of God's Spirit

From time to time I'll hear a Christian
who is facing some type of decision or test
express the desire to be visited by an angel. "I
just wish God would send an angel down here
and tell me what to do," they say.

Well, I'd like to see an angel just as much
as the next guy, but I've learned that when it
comes to getting direction and guidance from
Heaven, we believers have a much better deal.
We've been given the Spirit of God himself to

dwell on the inside of us 24 hours a day, 365
days a year!

Think about it. Which would you rather
have, a visit from an angel with a message
once or twice a year, or the Holy Spirit of God
communing with you every minute of every
day? That's precisely what we have. The
problem is, very few of us take advantage of
this wonderful resource.

The Holy Spirit has been provided to be
your constant companion and comfort.

*And I will pray the Father, and he
shall give you another Comforter, that he
may abide with you for ever; (John
14:16)*

At work, at home, awake or asleep, the
Holy Spirit is there on the inside of you ready
to communicate the will of God to your spirit.

When you need to know the truth about a situation, the Spirit is there to lead you to it.

It's His job.

Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth,

is come, he will guide you into all truth:

for he shall not speak of himself; but

whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he

speak: and he will shew you things to

come. (John 16:13)

Did you see that? "*He will guide you into all truth...*" When you meet someone who is

trying to deceive you, the Spirit is there to

show you the truth. When you are faced with

two different options and you don't know

what to do, He will guide you to the truth.

God is no respecter of persons. It doesn't matter how much education you've received...

It doesn't matter how much money you have...

It doesn't matter where you've come from...

He will open all the vast resources of heaven's wisdom if you're His child.

Sometimes, when I'm dealing with a particular circumstance, the Spirit of God speaks to me in the midnight hour. He says, "Son, there is something wrong with that situation. Wake up and get My Word out."

When the Spirit speaks to you like that,

don't just roll over and go back to sleep.

When the Creator of the universe wants to talk to you, get up! Say, "Lord, what do you want to say to me?" If you don't hear anything, start praying. Pray in the Holy Spirit. Allow Him to pray through you. Praying in the Spirit will begin to pull the wisdom and counsel of God from your spirit. Then you can begin to get an understanding of it in your mind.

The Spirit also speaks through what has been called, "the inward witness." This refers to an inner prompting or impression through which you just "know" what God wants you to do. Hearing God in this way simply involves following the course of action which carries a "peace" with it.

God wants to speak to you. He'll do it, first and foremost through His written Word. But he'll also do it through the voice of the Holy Spirit. Receiving this kind of communication is absolutely vital if you are going to successfully come out of trouble.

Part 2

The Comfort of the Holy Spirit

It's one thing to be able to hear from Heaven so you'll know how to come out of trouble. It's another thing to be able to have a

complete and total peace while you're in the process of coming out.

If you want to be the kind of believer that walks in quiet confidence and assurance no matter what the circumstances, you're going to have to learn to walk in the comfort of the Holy Ghost.

Then had the churches rest throughout all Judaea and Galilee and Samaria, and were edified; and walking in the fear of the Lord, and in the comfort of the Holy Ghost... (Acts 9:31)

God wants the blessing of His comfort to cover and envelop your life. But for that to

happen you're going to have to start walking in the fear of the Lord. Fear, in this case, simply means "honor, reverence and submission."

To fear God is to hate evil. To fear God is to quickly make changes in your life when you see in the Word that adjustments need to be made. This is the prerequisite to experiencing the comfort of the Holy Spirit. How does the Holy Spirit comfort us? In many ways. One of which is by showing us all the things that are ours in Christ Jesus.

Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of

*God; that we might know the things that
are freely given to us of God. (I
Corinthians 2:12)*

Did you catch that? One of the roles of the
Spirit in your life is to show you all the things
that have been freely given to you by God.
Your Heavenly Father has given you so much
that it takes His very Spirit working on the

inside of you for you to begin to grasp it all!
That's true comfort.

The Spirit of God wants to reveal to you
that you don't have to be sick. Healing is
yours in Christ Jesus. He wants to show that
you don't have to be poor and broke all the
time. All sufficiency is yours in the Lord.
When you're in the midst of trouble, all the
benefits of salvation are ready to be revealed
to you through the comforting work of the
Holy Spirit.

Walking in the Spirit

In the verse we just read (I Corinthians
2:12) Paul says we have been given the Holy
Spirit "... *that we might know the things that
are freely given us by God.*"

In the very next verse he tells us how to
receive that wonderful knowledge.

*Which things also we speak, not in
the words which man's wisdom teacheth,*

but which the Holy Ghost teacheth;

comparing spiritual things with spiritual.

(I Corinthians 2:13)

To really experience the fulness of the comfort of the Holy Spirit, you're going to have to become spiritually minded. You're going to have to know what it means to walk in the Spirit.

There are many things you need to know which simply cannot be grasped with the natural mind. Too frequently, when God speaks to us we end up scratching our heads asking, "Was that you Lord? Or was that me?"

There is only one reliable way to make sure you're hearing the voice of God. That is to be so familiar with His Word through Bible study and His voice through spending time with Him, that you immediately recognize it when it comes. You see, God's spoken words will never contradict His written Word. They are always harmonious. They are always in agreement.

When my wife calls me on the phone, I

immediately know it's her. How? Because I've spent enough time with her to be able to instantly recognize her voice. Likewise, you'll know the voice of God by spending time with

Him. There is no other way.

To truly know and understand the things
God has freely bestowed upon you takes time
and diligence applied to spiritual things. It
requires that you give attention to the things
of God so that your inner man is nurtured and
strengthened.

Then, as you hear and obey the counsel of
the Lord, you experience the comfort of the
Holy Ghost. That's the key to receiving this
blessed comfort. Hear and obey. It's as simple
as that.

When tough times come, you can be one
of those who comes through without a scratch.
When the storms of life come crashing in,
you'll be the one who stands steady as a rock.
Others around you may fall. Everyone you
know may be wringing their hands and crying
"What shall we do?" But you will know

nothing but calm assurance.

Peace of mind. Miraculous deliverance.

Supernatural wisdom and insight. All this and
much, much more belongs to the man or
woman who applies these principles and
learns the secret of hearing from God and
walking in the comfort of the Holy Spirit.
